PER CURIAM:

Shadreck Kifayatuthelezi appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge, granting summary judgment to the Appellees, and dismissing Kifayatuthelezi's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2018) civil rights claims and his claims under the South Carolina Tort Claims Act, S.C. Code Ann. §§ 15-78-10 to 15-78-220. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Kifayatuthelezi v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, No. 8:17-cv-03139-TLW (D.S.C. Sept. 25, 2019).
