## PER CURIAM:

Nelson L. Bruce appeals the district court's text order denying his Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b) motion seeking relief from the court's prior order denying both his motion to compel arbitration and a separate Rule 60(b) motion. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
