PER CURIAM:

Mark Anthony James petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging that the district court has unduly delayed in ruling on his 28 U.S.C. § 2255 (2018) motion. Our review of the district court's docket reveals that, on March 27, 2020, the district court denied relief on James' motion. *James v.
