PER CURIAM:

Ambrose Clark appeals the district court's order granting FedEx Freight, Inc.'s, motion for summary judgment in Clark's employment discrimination action. On appeal, we confine our review to the issues raised in the Appellant's brief. *See* 4th Cir. R. 34(b). Because the informal brief does not challenge the bases for the district court's dispositive holdings, Clark has forfeited appellate review of the court's disposition. *See Jackson v. Lightsey*, 775 F.3d 170, 177 (4th Cir. 2014) ("The informal brief is an important document; under Fourth Circuit rules, our review is limited to issues preserved in that brief."). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's judgment. We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
