PER CURIAM:

Edrian Donyae Wright appeals the district court's order dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 complaint without prejudice for failure to comply with a court order. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). We have reviewed the record and find no abuse of discretion. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Wright v.
