## PER CURIAM:

Larry Williams appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge, dismissing Williams' 42 U.S.C. § 1983 claim for failure to exhaust administrative remedies, and declining to exercise supplemental jurisdiction over Williams' remaining state law claim.
