PER CURIAM:

Rodney Wilson appeals the district court's order granting Wilson's counseled motion for a sentence reduction pursuant to § 404(b) of the First Step Act of 2018, Pub. L. No. 115-391, 132 Stat. 5194.^{*} We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *United States v. Wilson*, No. 4:03-cr-70134-NKM-3 (W.D. Va. July 29, 2020).
