PER CURIAM:

Gregory Allen Reeves appeals the district court's order denying his motion for compassionate release under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A). Upon review of the record, we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion in denying the motion. *See United States v. Kibble*, \_\_\_ F.3d \_\_\_, \_\_\_, No. 20-7009, 2021 WL 1216543, at \*2 (4th Cir. Apr. 1, 2021) (stating standard of review). Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *United States v. Reeves*, No. 7:15-cr-00047-GEC-1 (W.D. Va. Aug. 26, 2020). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
