PER CURIAM:

David Keith Miles appeals the district court's order denying Miles' motion for reconsideration of the court's order denying Miles' motion for compassionate release, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A), as amended by the First Step Act of 2018, Pub. L. No. 115-391, § 603(b)(1), 132 Stat. 5194, 5239, and also denying Miles' self-styled "successive emergency motion for compassionate release." We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *See United States v. Miles*, No. 3:02-cr-00548-CMC-33 (D.S.C. Nov. 20, 2020). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
