PER CURIAM:

Roger Charles Day, Jr., petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging that the district court has unduly delayed acting on his motion for compassionate release under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A). He seeks an order from this court directing the district court to act. Our review of the district court's docket reveals that the district court denied the motion on January 27, 2021. Accordingly, because the district court has recently decided Roger's motion, we deny the mandamus petition as moot.
