PER CURIAM:

Winfred F. Nicholson appeals from the district court's order dismissing his complaint in which he asserted claims against the credit union based on its compliance with a notice of levy from the Internal Revenue Service. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Nicholson v. UNIFY Fin. Credit Union*, No. 1:20-cv-01333-RDA-TCB (E.D. Va. Sept. 23, 2021).
