PER CURIAM:

Antonio C. Monroe appeals the district court's order granting Defendant summary judgment in Monroe's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action alleging Defendant was deliberately indifferent to Monroe's serious medical needs. On appeal, we confine our review to the issues raised in the informal brief. *See* 4th Cir. R. 34(b). Because Monroe's informal brief does not challenge the basis for the district court's disposition, he has forfeited appellate review of the court's order. *See Jackson v. Lightsey*, 775 F.3d 170, 177 (4th Cir. 2014) ("The informal brief is an important document; under Fourth Circuit rules, our review is limited to issues preserved in that brief."). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.

AFFIRMED
