PER CURIAM:

Tony B. Alexander appeals the district court's orders affirming the magistrate judge's order directing that Alexander be detained pending resolution of a supervised release revocation petition, and denying his motion for reconsideration.* We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. *See United States v. Clark*, 865 F.2d 1433, 1437 (4th Cir. 1989). Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *United States v. Alexander*, No. 3:18-cr-00202-MOC-DSC-1 (W.D.N.C.
