PER CURIAM:

Tinesha L. Bert appeals the district court's order denying her motion for compassionate release pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A)(i). We review a district court's denial of a motion for compassionate release for an abuse of discretion. *United States v. Kibble*, 992 F.3d 326, 329 (4th Cir. 2021). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. We also deny Bert's motion to appoint counsel. We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
