PER CURIAM:

Yayah Talib appeals the district court's order denying his motion for compassionate release under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A). After reviewing the record, we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion in denying Talib's motion. *See United States v. Kibble*, 992 F.3d 326, 329 (4th Cir.) (stating standard of review), *cert. denied*, 142 S. Ct. 383 (2021). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. *United States v. Talib*, No. 2:07-cr-00003-JPJ-1 (W.D. Va. Oct. 8, 2021).
