PER CURIAM:

Lisa Antoine appeals the district court's order granting Defendant summary judgment and denying Antoine summary judgment on Antoine's discrimination and retaliation claims, brought pursuant to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17, and the Age Discrimination in Employment Act, 29 U.S.C. §§ 621 to 634. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. *Antoine v. Delancy LLC*, No. 3:20-cv-00523-GCM (W.D.N.C. July 13, 2022).
