PER CURIAM:

Dora L. Adkins appeals the district court's order adopting the recommendation of the magistrate judge, denying her requests for leave to file an emergency complaint and for leave to proceed on that complaint in forma pauperis, and dismissing her case. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we grant Adkins' motions for leave to amend her informal opening brief and affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Adkins v. Ashford TRS Alexandria, LLC*, No. 1:22-cv-00790-PTG-WEF (E.D. Va. Dec. 16, 2022). We deny Adkins' motions to reverse and remand, for leave to reverse and remand, for leave to vacate and remand, to replace, for leave to replace, to amend, for leave to amend, and for leave to amend and moot all other motions.
