PER CURIAM:

Gregory Daniels appeals the district court's orders denying his motions for compassionate release pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A), as amended by the First Step Act of 2018, Pub. L. No. 115-391, § 603(b)(1), 132 Stat. 5194, 5239 and for reconsideration. We review a district court's denial of a compassionate release motion for abuse of discretion. *United States v. Kibble*, 992 F.3d 326, 329 (4th Cir.), *cert. denied*, 142 S. Ct. 383 (2021). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's orders. *United States v. Daniels*, No. 1:03-cr-00083-MR-1 (W.D.N.C. July 13, 2020 & Jan. 26, 2022). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
