PER CURIAM:

Eugene Asomani Williams appeals the district court's order denying his motion for compassionate release. We have reviewed the record on appeal and conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion in denying relief. *See United States v. Kibble*, 992 F.3d 326, 329 (4th Cir.) (providing standard), *cert. denied*, 142 S. Ct. 383 (2021). Accordingly, we affirm. *United States v. Williams*, No. 1:13-cr-00464-LMB-1 (E.D. Va. Feb. 1, 2022).
