PER CURIAM:

In these consolidated cases, Dalton Alonzo Dixon appeals the district court's orders (a) dismissing Dixon's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b); and (b) denying his Fed. R. Civ.
