PER CURIAM:

Robert Peter Russell appeals the district court's order construing his letter as a renewed motion for compassionate release, 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A)(i), and denying relief. We discern no abuse of discretion in the district court's decision, *see United States v. Kibble*, 992 F.3d 326, 329-31 (4th Cir.) (providing standard of review), *cert. denied*, 142 S. Ct. 383 (2021), and we therefore affirm.
