PER CURIAM:

Mark Wayne Woods appeals the district court's order denying his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A)(i) motion for compassionate release. Upon review, we discern no abuse of discretion in the district court's determination that Woods failed to demonstrate an extraordinary and compelling basis for relief. *See United States v. High*, 997 F.3d 181, 185 (4th Cir. 2021). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order.
