PER CURIAM:

Darrell L. Goss appeals the district court's orders adopting the recommendation of the magistrate judge, granting summary judgment to Defendants in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 civil rights action, and denying his request for injunctive relief, and denying his motions for reconsideration and to alter or amend judgment.
