PER CURIAM:

Peter George Liounis appeals the district court's order dismissing for lack of subject matter jurisdiction his civil action seeking relief under the Federal Tort Claims Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 1346(b), 2671-80. We have reviewed the record and discern no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. *Liounis v. United States*, No. 5:22-cv-00201-JPB-JPM (N.D.W. Va.
