## PER CURIAM:

Phil Caprice Howard, a federal prisoner, appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and dismissing without prejudice Howard's 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition in which Howard challenged the execution of his sentence. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. *Howard v. Janson*, No. 1:22-cv-03824-BHH (D.S.C. Feb. 9, 2023).
