PER CURIAM:

Malcom A. Jordan appeals the district court's order dismissing his complaint for failure to comply with the magistrate judge's order directing Jordan to correct certain deficiencies in his complaint. Although the magistrate judge warned Jordan that failure to comply could result in the dismissal of his action, Jordan did not remedy the identified deficiencies. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's judgment. *Jordan v. Pomeroy*, No. 5:23-ct-03012-BO-RJ (E.D.N.C. Feb. 23, 2023).
