## PER CURIAM:

Jeffrey Scott Adkins appeals the district court's order granting summary judgment to Defendants in Adkins' 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action alleging violations of his procedural due process rights in connection with the Virginia Parole Board's denial of parole.
