PER CURIAM:

Timothy Alan Overcash appeals the district court's order denying his third motion for compassionate release pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A). We have reviewed the record and conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion in denying Overcash's motion. *See United States v. Centeno-Morales*, 90 F.4th 274, 280 (4th Cir. 2024) (stating standard). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. *United States v. Overcash*, No. 3:16-cr-00260-RJC-DSC-1 (W.D.N.C.
