The attorney appointed to represent Leslie Redmond has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Redmond has filed a response. The record is insufficiently developed to allow consideration at this time of Redmond's claims of ineffective assistance of counsel. See *United States v. Cantwell*, 470 F.3d 1087, 1091 (5th Cir. 2006). Our independent review of the record, counsel's brief, and Redmond's response discloses no nonfrivolous issue for appeal. Accordingly, the motion for
