PER CURIAM:*

The court has carefully reviewed this § 1983 appeal in light of the briefs and pertinent parts of the record. Having done so, we find no reversible error of law or fact. The district court correctly concluded that the plaintiff failed to allege the existence of an official policy or custom attributable to Harris County. See Cox v. City of Dallas, 430 F.3d 734, 748-49 (5th Cir. 2006). The court also acted within its discretion by denying leave

to amend the complaint. See Goldstein v. MCI WorldCom, 340 F.3d 238, 254-55 (5th Cir. 2003). We therefore AFFIRM for essentially the reasons stated by the trial court.
