Ramon Daniel Morales-Corbala, federal prisoner # 52818-208, an alien against whom the Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement has issued a detainer subjecting him to immediate removal from the United States upon release from Bureau of Prisons (BOP) custody, appeals the denial of his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition challenging the BOP's exclusion of him from rehabilitation programs and halfway houses. The petition is foreclosed by this

court's decision in *Gallegos-Hernandez v. United States*, 688 F.3d 190, 192-93 (5th Cir. 2012), *petition for cert. filed* (Sept. 14, 2012) (No. 12-6450). Morales-Corbala's motion to expedite the appeal or for summary affirmance is denied.
