Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED in part as frivolous, *see* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2, and in part as moot. *See United States v. Rosenbaum-Alanis*, 483 F.3d 381, 382-83 (5th Cir. 2007).
