Alanis, 483 F.3d 381, 382 (5th Cir. 2007); see also United States v. Oriakhi, No. 94-6605, 1994 WL 440387, at *1 (5th Cir. Aug. 16, 1994). Accordingly, Appellant's appeal is dismissed as moot.
