nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED; counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein; and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. See 5TH CIR. R. 42.2. Zamora's untimely motion to appoint new counsel is DENIED. Cf. United States v. Wagner, 158 F.3d 901, 902–03 (5th Cir. 1998).
