nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2. Cisneros's motions to withdraw counsel's *Anders* brief, to have counsel file an appropriate brief showing clear and specific facts of the case, to remand the case, and to compel counsel to file an appropriate brief are DENIED.
