The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Edwin Orlando Caballero-Guardado has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). During the pendency of the appeal, Caballero-Guardado completed his 8-month term of imprisonment and has been deported. We have reviewed counsel's brief and the relevant portions of

the record reflected therein. We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED in part as frivolous, see 5TH CIR. R. 42.2, and in part as moot, see, e.g., United States v. Prieto, 801 F.3d 547, 549 n.1 (5th Cir. 2015).
