The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Jerry Lewis Dedrick has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Dedrick filed a response but subsequently died. Accordingly, his appeal is DISMISSED as moot, *see United States v. Douglas*,
