The attorney appointed to represent Morris Brown Okolo has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Okolo has not filed a response. Although Okolo remains subject to a term of supervised release, he has completed the revocation term of imprisonment. We have reviewed counsel's brief and the relevant portions of the record reflected

therein. We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED in part as frivolous, *see* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2, and in part as moot, *see United States v. Heredia-Holguin*, 823 F.3d 337, 340 (5th Cir. 2016) (en banc).
