nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2. Byrd's untimely motions for the appointment of new counsel and to proceed pro se on appeal are DENIED. Byrd's requests for an extension of time are also DENIED.
