JUDGMENT

IN CONSIDERATION WHEREOF, it is ORDERED that the district court's dismissal of Static Control's claims under the Latham Act and certain claims under North Carolina state law is REVERSED, and the case is REMANDED for further proceedings consistent with the opinion of this court.
