JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE was heard on the record from the district court and was argued by counsel.

IN CONSIDERATION WHEREOF, and for the reasons more fully set forth in the Court's opinion of even date, it is ORDERED that the award for work involving review of the Governor's proposal is AFFIRMED and the award for fees involving work in *John B., Ware, and Daniels* is VACATED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the overall percentage reduction and the award for work in *Rosen*, the HAT injunction, opposing plaintiffs-intervenors, work categorized as public relations, negotiations with legislators and the Governor, and analyzing the soft-limits initiative are VACATED and REMANDED to the district court for further proceedings.
