THIS CAUSE was heard on the record from the district court and was argued by counsel.

IN CONSIDERATION WHEREOF, it is ORDERED that the judgment of the district court as to the campaigning, speeches, endorsements, acting as a leader, and misleading statements clauses, and as to the facial challenge to the false statements clause, is AFFIRMED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the district court's judgment on the contributions clause and the as-applied challenge to the false statements clause is REVERSED, its judgment on the commits clause is VACATED, and the case is REMANDED for further consideration of that clause's meaning and validity.
