PER CURIAM.

Calvin Allen appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse judgment in his action brought under 42 U.S.C. §§ 1981, 1983, and 1985 for the denial of a liquor license. Following careful review, see *Casazza v. Kiser*, 313 F.3d 414, 418 (8th Cir. 2002) (de novo review of dismissal); *Dulany v. Carnahan*, 132 F.3d 1234, 1237 (8th Cir. 1997) (de novo review of summary judgment), we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *See* 8th Cir. R. 47B. We do not consider Allen's tendered "Motion to Vacate, Set Aside, and Remand Summary Judgment Request Oral Argument," and order that it be stricken.
