PER CURIAM.

Calvin Allen appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse judgment in his action brought under 42 U.S.C. §§ 1981, 1983, and 1985 for the denial of a liquor license. Following careful review, see *Casazza v. Kiser*, 313 F.3d 414, 418 (8th Cir. 2002) (de novo review of dismissal); *Dulany v. Carnahan*, 132 F.3d 1234, 1237 (8th Cir. 1997) (de novo review of summary judgment), we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See 8th Cir. R. 47B. We do not consider Allen's tendered "Motion to Vacate, Set Aside, and Remand Summary Judgment Request Oral Argument," and order that it be stricken.
