PER CURIAM.

Paul Love appeals the district court's¹ order dismissing his action based on the court's determination that the parties had reached a settlement agreement. Having carefully reviewed the record, we agree with the district court that the parties reached a settlement agreement at their August 23, 2005 meeting, and that the terms of the agreement are embodied in the transcript of the meeting. <u>See Chaganti & Assocs.</u>

<u>P.C. v. Nowotny</u>, 470 F.3d 1215, 1221 (8th Cir. 2006) (appeals court reviews for clear error district court's finding that settlement agreement existed), <u>cert. denied</u>, 75 U.S.L.W. 3569 (U.S. June 18, 2007) (No. 06-1377). In addition, we find nothing in the record to support Love's unsubstantiated claim that he was coerced into the agreement.

Accordingly, we affirm. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
