PER CURIAM.

Joseph Johnson appeals the district court's¹ dismissal and grant of summary judgment in favor of defendants in this action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 and <u>Bivens v.</u> <u>Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics</u>, 403 U.S. 388 (1971). Having carefully reviewed the record and considered Johnson's arguments, we find

no basis for reversal. <u>See Federer v. Gephardt</u>, 363 F.3d 754, 757 (8th Cir. 2004) (de novo standard of review for Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6) dismissal); <u>Anderson v. Larson</u>, 327 F.3d 762, 767 (8th Cir. 2003) (de novo standard of review for grant of summary judgment). Accordingly, we affirm. <u>See</u> 8th Cir. R. 47B.
