PER CURIAM.

Missouri prisoners Kenneth Bell and Cleophus Mack appeal the district court's¹ 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b) preservice dismissal of their complaint. Upon de novo review, <u>Cooper v. Schriro</u>, 189 F.3d 781, 783 (8th Cir. 1999) (per curiam) (standard of review), we conclude dismissal was proper because the five-year limitations period had expired. <u>See Mo. Rev. Stat. § 516.120(4); Wallace v. Kato</u>, 127 S. Ct. 1091, 1094 (2007) (holding § 1983 actions are characterized as personal-injury actions for purposes of determining which state statute of limitations to apply). However, we

modify the judgment to be with prejudice, <u>see Botten v. Shorma</u>, 440 F.3d 979, 980-81 (8th Cir. 2006) (affirming dismissal of plaintiff's complaint with prejudice on statute of limitations grounds), and we affirm the judgment as modified. <u>See</u> 8th Cir. R. 47B.
