PER CURIAM.

North Dakota inmate Anthony James Moore appeals the district court's¹ adverse grant of summary judgment in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. Having conducted de novo review of the record, <u>see Johnson v. Blaukat</u>, 453 F.3d 1108, 1112 (8th Cir. 2006), we find no basis for reversal. Accordingly, we affirm. <u>See</u> 8th Cir. R. 47B. However, as to Moore's claim alleging a lack of exercise in administrative segregation, we amend the dismissal to be without prejudice, as the record shows he

did not administratively exhaust this claim before filing the instant lawsuit. <u>See</u> <u>Johnson v. Jones</u>, 340 F.3d 624, 627 (8th Cir. 2003) (inmate must exhaust before filing suit, or dismissal is mandatory).
