PER CURIAM.

Arkansas inmate Dewayne Hughes appeals following the district court's¹ adverse grant of summary judgment in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. Having carefully reviewed the record, see Roe v. Crawford, 514 F.3d 789, 793 (8th Cir.) (standard of review), cert. denied, 129 S.
