PER CURIAM.

David Johnson appeals following the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse grant of summary judgment in his employment-discrimination action and the court's ensuing denial of his motion for reconsideration. After careful de novo review, <u>see Davis v. KARK-TV</u>, <u>Inc.</u>, 699, 703 (8th Cir. 2005), we conclude that summary judgment was proper for the reasons stated by the district court; and we also conclude that the court did not abuse

its discretion in denying reconsideration, <u>see McAninch v. Wintermute</u>, 491 F.3d 759, 775 (8th Cir. 2007). Accordingly, we affirm. <u>See</u> 8th Cir. R. 47B.
